**MATTERS RAISED BY THE PUBLIC**

**Cllr Cooke: Mud on Sandy Lane (Moss Gate) caused by a member of the public's tractor.** Cllr Cooke reported that a member of the public had approached him whilst at Moss Gate and complained about the mud on the road (Sandy Lane) that had been caused by a neighbour in his tractor. Cllr Cooke confirmed the mud was excessive and dangerous. Cllr Cooke informed the complainant that it was a Highways issue and that they should forward this to them as a priority.

## **OTHER MATTERS REQUIRING A DECISION BY THE COUNCIL**

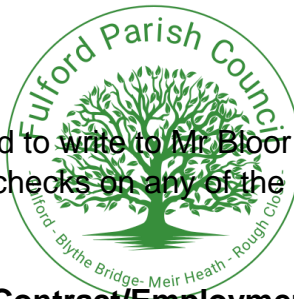
### **1. Staffing: (Closed item)**

**Action:** Proposed applicant voted in by full council.

- 2. Parish Maintenance Jobs (Outstanding)** – Chairman Brunt updated the council on the progress of works undertaken by Barry Vickers (Contractor). He expressed the thanks and appreciation for the work on the bus shelters, bollards and the red telephone boxes at Rough Close and Moss Gate.

Chairman Brunt informed the Council that he had been contacted by a Mr Chad Bloor who had informed him that he had checked the Defibrillators.

Cllr White confirmed Mr Chad Bloor was no longer connected to the Fulford First Responders and is unsure why he would be checking them as that is a task the Parish Council had previously agreed the Fulford First Responders would do.



**Action:** Council agreed to write to Mr Bloor and inform him that he should no longer undertake any checks on any of the defibrillators owned by Fulford Parish Council.

3. **Parish Maintenance Contract/Employment**

The council feel as though the maintenance contracts are disjointed and not fit for current purposes.

**Action:** A working group to be set up and discuss what is needed and report to full council. The Clerk is to pull together all contractor information reading for severing and re-tendering.

4. **Christmas Display** – Cllr Hamilton suggested that after the positive comments from the increase in Tommy silhouettes it would be nice to do something Christmas related. Discussion were had about what a Christmas display might look like.

**Action:** Cllr Hamilton was to project manage Christmas and form a working group.

5. **Grindley Park Management Plan** – Cllr Cooke highlighted the risk to the council of not having a management plan for council assets such as Grindley Park due to risk of tree fall in winter storms or that the park wasn't being managed to any set plan.

**Action:** Grindley Park Working Group to meet and discuss/formulate a plan and report back to full council
