**MATTERS RAISED BY THE PUBLIC**

**Cllr Cooke: V12 – Transporter.** Cllr Cooke reported a serious incident where an elderly and disabled member of the public was horrendously verbally abused by the driver of the Transporter lorry to the V12 garage. The member of the public took issue with the transporter being parked over the pavement blocking the elderly member from passing in his mobility scooter.

**Action:** Council agree to send a letter to Staffordshire Police and the Transporter Company regarding the matter on the advice of Councillor Parry.

**Cllr Oxby: Footpath 35**

A footpath is shown passing through one property and across the rear grounds of another and the corner of the Village Hall grounds.  
This footpath has been redundant for 50 years.

**Action:** Support a resident's submission for its closure.

**Cllr Wilkinson: Spotgate Crossroads** – Dangers of the crossroads and lack of signage.

**Action:** Cllr Parry agreed to push this matter with the relevant bodies regarding surveys and signage. The Council agreed to look at subsidising the cost of digital speed signage where and when necessary.
